

Blink and you might just miss Kensho Boutique. One of Greece's hippest hotels, it sits discreetly behind unassuming sliding glass doors in Ornos Beach, a mega party hub (and summer retreat of swathes of 'It' DJs, actors and celebs), just far enough from the beach to provide a soothing haven. From the moment you arrive, you'll be treated like a princess: think Hermès tissues to dab your brow and a freshly squeezed juice, chilled to perfection. Every inch of the hotel is thoughtfully designed: contemporary decor is offset by natural materials, such as local stone and bleached driftwood, for a cool and comfy vibe, and rooms are effortlessly chic (junior suites feature free-standing baths and secluded plunge pools). Dining here is sublime, with a 10-course menu that takes you on a culinary journey through Greece: poached lobster and king crab, pork belly, red mullet and a dreamy stifado wagyu beef stew – plus desserts! Equally satisfying is a trip to The Cave, a rocky, otherworldly haven inside the hotel's spa – serenity guaranteed. At night, when the pool sparkles a rainbow of colours, head to the rooftop bar overlooking the bay for a Myconian Breezer to sip under the stars. (*Brides* loved this cocktail so much, we got the recipe!)

WINNING STREAK The chic decor – the chunky carved wooden headboards and the cool bamboo swinging chair, in particular, will have you furiously Googling to find similar designs for your bedroom at home.
