Aimed at young trendy travellers, formal buffets are out and a 24/7 self-service kitchen is in, with sushi, currywurst and spätzle for the taking. The fast wi-fi facilitates a digital guestbook, streaming guests' videos and Instagram uploads, while floor-to-ceiling art differentiates each room. Conferences can be relaxed affairs, with beanbags, blackboards and wooden elephants in the Moxy's meeting spaces.

Even the air is chic, scented with spicy musk, perfuming evening arts events and dinner at the high-end Réjane

Brasserie. The general vibe is a quiet and discerning home from home – provided your home is very, very deluxe, that is.

All whitewashed stone walls, stripped-wood floorboards and minimalist white furniture, this Greek-island boutique has
